

Curriculum Vitae: Daniel D. Novotný

I am a post-doctoral researcher in “analytical scholasticism” at the University of South Bohemia in České Budějovice. Since 2010 I am editor-in-chief of *Studia Neoaristotelica: A Journal of Analytical Scholasticism*. I have co-edited two volumes in analytical metaphysics and authored a book in Baroque scholastic metaphysics. I have earned my PhD in Philosophy at SUNY Buffalo in 2008 under Jorge J. E. Gracia, Barry Smith, and John T. Kearnns.

At the moment (and in the foreseeable future) the primary focus of my research is scholasticism of the Baroque era, especially in so far as the issues that were discussed at that time may be related to issues discussed in contemporary philosophy. In addition I have been occasionally involved in various other areas, such as epistemology, semantics, informatics, education, philosophical practice, philosophy with children (P4C), interpretations of Laozi, applied ethics, etc.
