



Baden-Württemberg Scholarship Program 2017/2018

This scholarship is offered to selected students going to a university in the German federal state of Baden-Württemberg on student exchange. Its aim is to promote the international exchange of qualified German and international students. The scholarship program thus contributes to the global networking of people associated with Baden-Württemberg.

In framework of this program the Katholische Hochschule Freiburg (Catholic University of Applied Sciences Freiburg), Germany, offers scholarship for the students of partner universities.

Potential Candidates

This scholarship is available exclusively for students enrolled in our foreign partner universities. Scholarships are only awarded through nomination of a partner university.

Scholarship Rates and Duration

Scholarship rates and periods may vary according to variations in budget. Minimum monthly rate is: 500 Euro (Bachelor) and 600 Euro (Master)

According to the regulations of the Baden-Württemberg Foundation the minimum scholarship period per student is 3 months, the maximum period is 10 months.

Application Procedure

- 1) Partner institution sends scholarship nomination(s) together with the students' exchange application documents to the International Office at KH Freiburg.
- 2) The International Office will get in contact with the selected students. They will be asked to register their scholarship application online the link to the Online Portal of the Baden-Württemberg SCHOLARSHIP will be sent by email.
- 3) After approval, Baden-Württemberg SCHOLARSHIP foundation will email scholarship contracts to selected students and students will have access to information on scholarship value and duration.

The Selection Process

The Baden-Württemberg Foundation chooses the final scholarship recipients following a preliminary selection carried out by the KH Freiburg. Preliminary decisions will be sent in May and the final decisions will be communicated to applicants latest in June.

Personal report

At the end of the scholarship, students are expected to write a reflection paper (maximum 5 pages on DIN A4 paper) about their study abroad experience. Please upload the personal report in the BWS World portal four weeks after your study abroad.

No Combination of Scholarships

Students may not receive any other scholarships in addition to the Baden-Württemberg Scholarship having the same focus.
