ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO STUDY AT THE FACULTY OF THEOLOGY AT USB IN ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 IN BACHELOR'S, MASTER'S (POSTGRADUATE), AND DOCTORAL STUDY PROGRAMMES

(1) Doctoral Study Programme Religion, Culture, and Public Life.

The program is currently undergoing the accreditation process at the Ministry of Education. If accreditation is granted, as is expected, the admissions process will be announced no later than July 2026. The date of the entrance exam is determined by the University of Padua; the expected timeframe is September–October 2026.

Form of study: full-time

Language of instruction: English

Expected number of admitted students: 1

Expected assessment of the application: The entrance examination will be conducted in English at the **University of Padua** in the form of an interview before the **Academic Board**.

This is a joint degree study programme implemented by a consortium of universities in Padua and Turin (Italy), Nicosia (Cyprus), and Montevideo (Uruguay). The University of South Bohemia is in the process of joining this consortium as part of the accreditation procedure. The programme focuses on the role of religion in the public sphere within the context of religious and cultural pluralism. It prepares students for independent scholarly and creative work in the fields of philosophy, theology, religious studies, and sociology of religion. Each student is required to complete a foreign study placement of 3–18 months at one of the partner universities.
